

- as a part of this their bill of Complaint as of here inserted in words and figures, your orators further state that the house and lot specified in the above recited clause is the same decedent in the case filed herewith as Exhibits No 2-3 & 4, that said Mary Storm died in the month of November in the year Eighteen Hundred and sixty two - that said Mariam Elizabeth Storm was married to one George W. Cromwell and died some eight or nine years ago, leaving her said husband surviving her and the following named Children as her only heirs at law, viz; Oliver Franklin Cromwell, Georgeanna M. E. Cromwell, Leonard Lydia Cromwell - who has since been married to Lewis Stein, and Charles C. Cromwell, - that said Lydia Rebecca Storm was married to one Jacob Dadyman and with her said husband, has since died leaving as her only child and heir at law Almira Eugenia Dadyman, who has since intermarried with one Charles Eader. - Your Orators are advised and charge that upon the death of said Peter Storm, the said house and lot of ground by a true construction of said Will, vested in said Peter Leonard Storm, Mariam E. Storm and Lydia R. Storm, subject to the life estate of said Mary Storm, and was held and owned by them as tenants in Common and that upon the death of said Mariam E. Cromwell, her interest in said house & lot descended to and vested in her above named Children and heirs at law, subject to the life-estate of their said father. - that upon the death of said Lydia R. Dadyman, her interest in said real estate vested in her above named Child and heir at law and that the said heirs at law now hold and own said house and lot of ground as tenants in Common with your orator Peter L. Storm, excepting that portion of said lot conveyed by said Mary Storm and Leonard Storm to Barbara and Alexander Haller by deed dated the 30th day of May 1829 and duly recorded in Liber L.S. No 31 folio 492 & 493 One of the said Records of said County, to which reference is hereby made for a description of that part so sold off. - Your Orators further state all of said parties are adults, except Charles C. Cromwell who is an infant under twenty one years of age and that they all reside in Frederick County, except Oliver F. Cromwell, who resides in Illinois beyond the limits of the State of Maryland and that said house and lot of ground can not be divided among said parties and that the interest of all said tenants in Common, infant as well as adults will be promoted by a sale of said real Estate. -

In tender Consideration whereof and for that your Orators are remediless in the premises by the strict rules of the Common Law and relivable only in a Court of Equity where matters of this nature are properly Cognizable; Do the and therefore that the said Oliver Franklin Cromwell and Martha J. Cromwell his wife, Georgeanna M. E. Cromwell, Lewis Stein and Leonard Lydia Stein his wife, Charles C. Cromwell, Charles W. Eader and Almira Eugenia Eader his wife, and George W. Cromwell may answer all and discharge the Charges and matters aforesaid and that said real Estate may be sold by a trustee to be appointed by your Honor and that your Orators may have all such other and further relief as the nature of the case may require and to your Honor shall seem meet; And may it please your Honor to grant unto your Orators an order of publication, giving notice to the said Charles C. Cromwell who is a non resident as before stated, of the substance and object of this bill warning him to appear in this Court in person or by solicitor, on or before a certain day to answer the premises and show cause if any he has why a decree should not pass as prayed and also a writ of Subpoena against the said George W. Cromwell, Oliver F. Cromwell and Martha J. his wife, Georgeanna M. E. Cromwell, Lewis Stein and Leonard L. Stein his wife, and Charles W. Eader and Almira Eugenia Eader his wife of Frederick County thereby commanding them and each of them to be and appear before your
