Marshall, as will appear by said mortgage deed, a true and certified copy whereof is filed herewith as Exhibit No 1 that the interest on said sum of three thousand dollars has been fully paid & satisfied to said Richard H. Marshall by John Arnold in his lifetime and since his death, by his administrators, up to the eleventh day of October in the year Eighteen hundred and sixty two and that the whole of said sum of three thousand dollars with interest thereon from said 11th day of October 1862 is now due and owing to said Richard H. Marshall and is a lien on said lands described in said deed of mortgage. - These Complainants state further that said John Arnold decd, seized of a parcel of land containing ninety square perches of land conveyed to him by deed by David Arnold, as will appear by said deed filed herewith as Exhibit No 5 - also of another tract of land containing one hundred and eight and three quarters acres conveyed to said John Arnold by Henry Shafer by deed, a true and certified copy whereof is filed herewith as Exhibit No 6, - Excepting therefrom one hundred and six and one half acres of said land conveyed by said John Arnold in his lifetime to Matthias Wheat by deed duly recorded in Liber H. B. S. No 11 folio 57, one of the land records of said County, to which reference is hereby made for that part of said land so sold and conveyed, - also of a tract of two acres of land conveyed to said John Arnold by John Locker by deed, a true and certified copy whereof is filed herewith as Exhibit No 7 - also of a tract of land containing two acres and twenty two square perches of land conveyed to said John Arnold by deed by Peter Nelson, which said deed is filed herewith as Exhibit No 8 - also of a small piece or parcel of land containing one acre and fifty four square perches of land purchased by said John Arnold of a certain Samuel Wheat and for which the said Samuel Wheat executed to said John Arnold a bond of conveyance and your Orators allege that said John Arnold paid the whole of the purchase money, for the same, all of which with a description of said land will appear by said bond of conveyance filed herewith as Exhibit No 9. - the whole of the aforementioned tracts or parts of tracts of land constituting what is known as 'the Home Farm' of said John Arnold - also of a part of a tract of land containing sixty one acres and two rods of land, conveyed to said John Arnold by John Heffler by deed which is filed herewith as Exhibit No 10 - also of a small piece or parcel of land conveyed to said John Arnold by Emanuel Shefer by deed as and for one half of an acre of land, subject to the right of the public to use the same to the grave yard for the purposes of burial and keeping said graveyard in repair, as will appear by said deed filed herewith as Exhibit No 11, said two pieces of land constituting what is known as the sixty acre farm, which said farm the said David Arnold and John Arnold, having a good offer for and by consent of the heirs at law of said John Arnold decd. sold to Daniel G. Puer at and for the sum of seventy dollars per acre, the purchase money to be paid, one third on the first day of April 1862 - one third on the first day of April 1863 and the balance on the first day of April 1864, the whole bearing interest from the first day of April 1862 and to be secured to the satisfaction of the Trustees, as will appear by the article of agreement filed herewith as Exhibit No 12 - also of a part of a tract of land called Hawthorn Settlements heretofore purchased by said John Arnold of his father, David Arnold, as and for one hundred and thirty acres more or less, as will appear by a copy of the contract of sale filed herewith as Exhibit No 13, and these Complainants charge that the whole of the purchase money for said lands
