Your Trustees also sold to Arthur Ansell and Thomas Ansell The "Round Run" of
the intestate, containing one hundred and ninety three acres, three rods and ten and half
square perches of land specified and embraced in Exhibits No 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7-8 and 9
in this case and more particularly described in the plat marked B and the survey,
filed as Exhibits I and J, A, No 1 and I and J, A, No 2 to this report of sale, at and for the
sum of seventy dollars per acre, the purchase money for the same amounting to thirteen
thousand five hundred and sixty seven dollars and ten cents and your Trustees file herewith
with their acknowledgment of purchase marked Exhibit I and J, A, No 3 to this report.

Your Trustees also sold to said Arthur Ansell and Thomas Ansell two small tracts
of Mountain land, one containing twenty eight acres and three rods, specified in Exhibit
No 15 in said case, and the other containing seven acres and three rods, adjoining the
mountain lands of Peter Ansell, John Gower and others, at and for the sum of three hundred
dollars and your Trustees file herewith their acknowledgment of purchase marked Exhibit
I and J, A, No 4 to this report.
