

balance of six thousand dollars shall be paid into my Estate as following; two thousand dollars on the first day of April 1842, and two thousand dollars on the first day of April 1843 and two thousand dollars on the first day of April 1844. I also give to my son Daniel a parcel of fifteen acres of Mountain land adjoining the Mountain land of Daniel Sheemaker, which fifteen acres shall be surveyed to my son Daniel aforesaid, by a parallel line with the line dividing the lands of said Sheemaker and myself, for which fifteen acres aforesaid my son Daniel shall pay into my Estate the sum of 225 dollars in the year 1845.

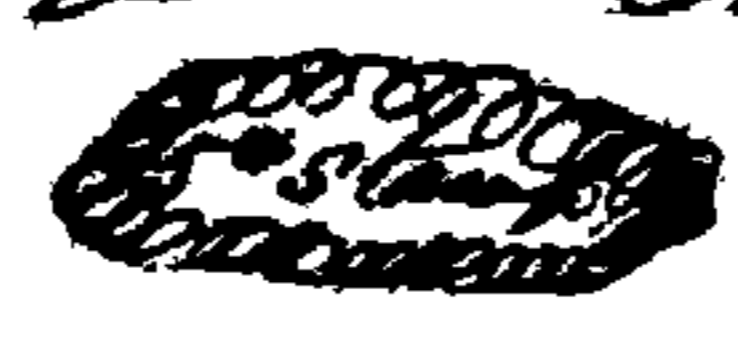
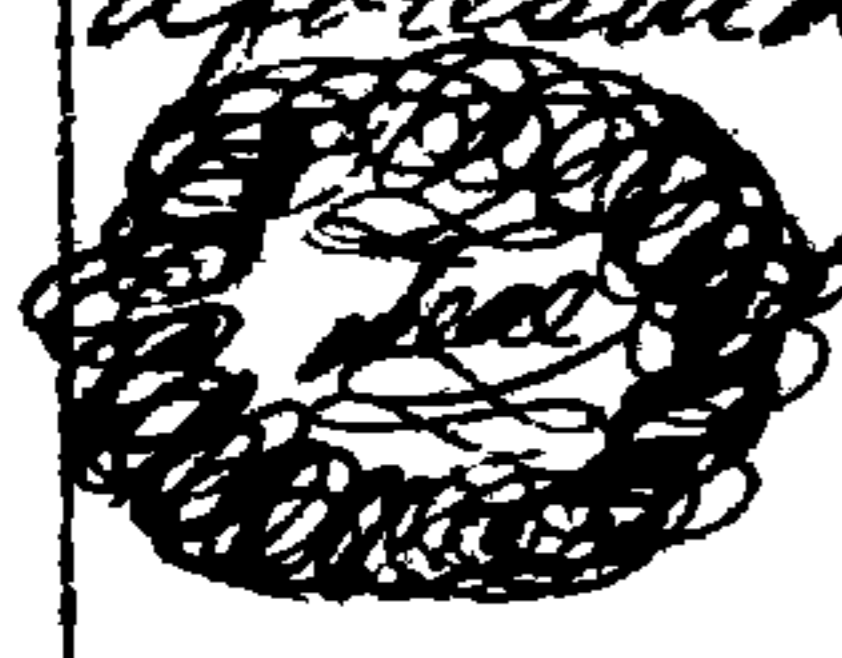

At the request of Daniel Sheffer the following deed was recorded April 27 1859.

This deed made this 21th day of November in the year Eighteen hundred and fifty eight by William Metzger of Frederick County in the State of Maryland, Son of George A. Main, Witnesseth, whereas by a deed of trust by the said George A. Main and Caroline Main his wife of Frederick County and State of Maryland executed on the 15th day of May Eighteen hundred and fifty eight, and duly recorded, the said George A. Main and Caroline Main his wife did appoint the said William Metzger trustee to sell all their lands and real Estate situated in Frederick County in the State of Maryland, being composed of several original tracts viz; part of a tract called 'The Journey on Mattotany'; part of 'Deep Hole'; and part of 'Addition to Deep Hole'; and whereas the said William Metzger did sell to Daniel Sheffer of Frederick County, in the State of Maryland, part of said lands, who has fully satisfied and paid the purchase money. Now therefore in consideration of the premises, the said William Metzger doth grant unto the said Daniel Sheffer, all the right and title of all the parties to, or in all that lot of ground situated in Frederick County, which is described as follows, viz; Beginning for the same at a stone standing at the end of the 10th line of the whole by acre span as it was lately surveyed, the same being in the public road, and running thence with it seven feet two courses, South 15° West 1 7/10 ft to a stone, South 55° East 65 1/10 ft to intersect a line of said Daniel Sheffer's farm then with said farm and the by acre span, allowing for variation North 26° East 67 1/4 ft to a stone, North 35° West 47 ft to a stone, North 58° West 30 ft to a stone, South 41° West 6 ft to a stone in the public road, then with said road South 15° West 3 3/10 perches to the place of beginning containing sixteen acres of land more or less.
