Sarah C. Florence S. Joseph P. and Thomas W. Reichart all infants under twenty one years of age and all residing in Frederick County, Maryland. -

To the 6th That he knows the real Estate of which Jacob Hyder died seized and possessed and as is described in the bill of Complaint and the proceedings in this case, that loss and injury would arise from a division thereof - that a sale thereof and a distribution of the proceeds would be advantageous to all parties interested. - Waives as to this deponent.

There being no other witnesses present to be examined, and the complainants desiring no further time for the production of their evidence, the Commissioner closed the said Commission and herewith returns the same under his hand and seal this 30th day of August in the year Eighteen hundred and sixty four. -
