At the request of Henry C. Doniphan the following Mortgage was recorded June 5th 1861. ~

This Mortgage made this 9th day of April in the year Eighteen hundred and sixty, by Albert Howe Jr. and Mary Ann Howe his wife all of Jackson County, in the State of Maryland, Witnesseth, that in consideration of the sum of two hundred and twenty five dollars with interest thence from the 3^d day of April 1860, now due and owing from the said Albert Howe Jr. and Mary Ann Howe his wife to Henry C. Doniphan of the County and State aforesaid upon a promissory note dated the 3^d day of April 1860 for the sum of two hundred and twenty five dollars payable one year after date with interest as also the sum of six hundred dollars, as Endorser (a security) payable to Joseph Shank in one, two and three years from the 3^d day of April 1860, with interest thence from date according to the tenor thereof. ~ The said Albert Howe Jr. and Mary Ann Howe his wife doth grant unto the said Henry C. Doniphan all that part of a tract or parcel of land lying in the Town of Woodcherry in the County and State aforesaid, known and distinguished by lot No 32, a reference to plat of said Town will more fully appear, containing 66 feet front and running back 163 feet to a board fence (by reference to a deed executed by Joseph Shank and wife bearing date the 21st day of April 1860, will more fully appear with all and singular the buildings and appurtenances therunto belonging. ~ Provided that if the said Albert Howe Jr. and Mary Ann Howe his wife shall pay the several sums mentioned in said notes, as the said notes shall severally fall due and shall also pay the several sums mentioned in said notes as the said notes shall severally fall due and shall also pay the interest annually upon all such sums as may be unpaid, after the maturity of the same -

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
