- Single bill with the interest aforesaid - and also for the purpose of securing & saving
 transfer the said Henry C. Dousif as security on three single bills executed by the said
 Albert Howe Jr and the said Henry C. Dousif to a certain Joseph Shank - all dated on
 the second day of April Eighteen hundred and sixty and payable respectively on the
 first day of April Eighteen hundred and sixty one - the 2^d on the first day of April
 Eighteen hundred and sixty two - and the 3^d on the first day of April Eighteen hundred
 and sixty three, each for the sum of two hundred dollars with interest from date, the said
 Albert Howe Jr and Mary Ann Howe his wife executed three deeds of Mortgage conveying
 certain real Estate situate and lying in the Town of Woodboro Frederick County, State
 of Maryland, to the said Henry C. Dousif which said property is described in Exhibits 5,
 filed in said proceedings.

The Bill further Charges that no part of the said sums of money mentioned in said
 Mortgage has been paid except the interest for one year on the single bill of the date
 of April third Eighteen hundred and sixty, for two hundred and twenty five dollars
 but that the whole of said sum of money together with the interest from the 2^d day
 of April Eighteen hundred and sixty except the interest on the note for two hundred and
 twenty five dollars as aforesaid is still due and unpaid to your Complainant who as
 security has paid the same, and prays that the mortgages premises aforesaid may be
 sold for payment of the Complainant's claim with the interest that may be due thereon,

The Bill further Charges that the said Albert Howe is a non-resident and does not
 reside in the State of Maryland.

It is thereupon ordered this 28th day of August in the year 1864 that the Com-
 plainant by causing a copy of this order to be inserted in some newspaper published at
 Frederick once a week for four successive weeks prior to the 30th day of September 1864,
 give notice to the said Albert defendant of the object and substance of this Bill, and
 warn him to appear in this Court in person or by solicitor on or before the first day
 of January 1865 to answer the premises and show cause if any he has why a decree ought
 not to pass as prayed.
