It is remembered that heretofore to wit on the 15th day of June 1864 came the said Complainants in Court here sitting by the said John A. Steiner Esq Solicitor and filed in Court here the following Bill and Exhibits.

Bill

To the Hon. Madison Nelson Circuit Judge for the fourth Judicial Circuit of the State of Maryland sitting in the Circuit Court for Frederick County as a Court of Equity.

The Bill of Complaint of Samuel Poparo and William H. Wagner of Frederick County State of Maryland shows, that a certain John Legore by his single bill dated on the third of April Eighteen hundred and sixty two, payable twelve months after date, with interest from date with one of your complainants Samuel Poparo as security therein was indebted to a certain David D Parkis in the sum of four hundred dollars, as well appear by a reference to said single bill herewith Exhibited marked Exhibit No 1 which with all other Exhibits hereinafter produced, your Complainants pray may be taken as part of this their bill of Complaint.

Your Complainants further state that the said John Legore was also indebted to the said William H. Wagner on the third day of April in the year Eighteen hundred and sixty two in the sum of five hundred dollars with interest from the date or note then held by David D Parkis - as well appear by the said note herewith Exhibited marked Exhibit No 2.

Your Complainants further state that the said John Legore in conjunction with his wife Elizabeth Legore for the purpose of securing the payments of the said sums of money hereinbefore mentioned as they respectively become due and payable and to indemnify and save harmless your Complainants and each of them from all harm and loss which they or either of them might sustain in respect of their respective liabilities or assumptions of debt for the said John Legore - did convey unto your Complainants all their lands situate lying and being in Frederick County State of Maryland described in said
