To the 3^d That he did not leave a widow.

To the 4th That he is the administrator of William Hockensmith & that the personal Estate of said William is not sufficient for the payment of his debts & that it will be necessary to sell a portion of his real estate to pay said debts & that he knows the real estate of which said William died seized and possessed & that it is the same as is described in the bill and Exhibits in this case.

To the 5th That he knows the handwriting of said William Hockensmith, that the signature attached to note now shown him and marked Exhibit No. 1 is in the proper handwriting of said William Hockensmith.

To the 6th That the value of the land described in Exhibit No. 2, is about fifteen hundred dollars, David Angew, a witness of lawful age, produced on the part of the Complainant being duly sworn and examined to interrogatories filed with the Commissioner and herewith returned deposes and says.

To the 7th That he is acquainted with all the parties to this suit that has known them for many years.

To the 8th That he knew William Hockensmith & that he is dead & that he died in May 1864 leaving two children, namely, Robert E. and Mary C. Hockensmith, both infants under the age of twenty one years and both reside in Frederick County Md. To the 9th That William Hockensmith left no widow. To the 10th That he knows the real Estate of which said William Hockensmith died, seized and possessed & that it is the same as is described in the bill and exhibits in this case.

To the 11th That he is acquainted with the handwriting of said William Hockensmith & has frequently seen him write & that the signature William Hockensmith attached to the note now shown him and marked Exhibit No. 1 is in the proper handwriting of said William Hockensmith.

To the 12th That the real Estate described in Exhibit No. 2 is worth about fifteen hundred dollars. At the same time Complainant filed with the Commissioner, as evidence Exhibit No. 1 and Nos. 2 & 3 which are herewith returned by Commissioner. There being no other witnesses present to be examined and the Complainant requiring no further time for the production of his evidences, the Commissioner closed the said Commission and herewith returns the same under his hand and seal, on this first day of November in the year Eighteen hundred and sixty four.
