

As it remembered and it is hereby certified that on this fourth day of March in the year One thousand Eight hundred and forty four before us the undersigned two Justices of the peace of the State of Maryland in and for the County of Frederick aforesaid personally appeared Conrad Lorne, and his wife Eliza Ann Lorne, they being known to us to be the persons whose names and described as and professing to be the persons and grantors in, and to the foregoing deed or indenture and did solemnly acknowledge the said indenture or instrument of writing to be their respective act and deed, the said Eliza Ann Lorne, having signed and sealed the said indenture before us, out of the presence and hearing of her said husband, and we further certify that we examined the said Eliza Ann Lorne wife of the said Conrad Lorne, out of the presence and hearing of her said husband, whether she executed and acknowledged the said indenture, or instrument of writing, freely and voluntarily and without being induced to do so by fear or threats of or ill usage by her said husband, or by fear of loss displeasure upon which examination she declared and said she did. At the request of Conrad Lorne the following deed was recorded October 26th 1857.

This Deed made this 30th day of July in the year Eighteen hundred and fifty seven by John Peaster dec^d and Elizabeth Peaster his wife, Witnesseth that in consideration of the sum of twenty five dollars the said John Peaster dec^d and Elizabeth Peaster his wife, doth grant unto Conrad Lorne, all that part of a tract of land in Frederick County and State of Maryland, beginning at a stone marker at the end of the 18th line of a deed from Jacob Peaster and others to John Peaster dated the 18th day of May 1832, and recorded in Liber J. S. No. 15 folios 708, 709, 710, 711, one of the said Records of Frederick County and running thence with said line reversed South 60th West 24th 1/2th feet then North 72th East 23th 1/2th feet to intersect the 13th line of said deed, then with said line reversed North 15th West 14th 1/2th feet to the first mentioned beginning and containing two fourths of an acre of land more or less.
