



Remarks.
A Represents the beginning of Lot No. 1. and the lines of which are numbered from 1. to 10 inclusive.

B Represents the beginning of Lot No. 2 and the lines of which are numbered from 1 to 8 inclusive.

Courses and Distances.

For part of a tract of land called 'The Cool Spring', beginning for Lot No. 1, at the beginning of the deed from Christopher Michael to Henry Crowe and Conrad Crowe dated 5th January 1844, and recorded in Liber N.S. No. 21, folio 310, one of the said Records of Frederick County and running thence with said deed connecting the same allowing 2¹/₄° for variation N 75¹/₄° E 24¹/₄ ft. S 87¹/₄° E 32¹/₄ ft. N 50¹/₄° E 14¹/₄ ft. N 17¹/₄° E 28¹/₄ ft. S 88¹/₄° E 6¹/₄ ft. to the East bank of a road and with it, N 26¹/₄° W 4¹/₄ ft. to a stake and pile of stones at the end of 30 ft. on the 11th line expressed in the deed aforesaid and with it connecting as aforesaid N 85¹/₄° W 44¹/₄ ft. S 61¹/₄° W 20¹/₄ ft. N 88¹/₄° W 20¹/₄ ft. Lot No. 2, For part of a tract of land called 'The Cool Spring', beginning at the end of 6 ft. on the 5th line expressed in the deed from Christopher Michael to Henry and Conrad Crowe dated 5th January 1844 and recorded in Liber N.S. folio 310, it being at a stake and pile of stones on the East side of a road and running thence with said deed aforesaid connecting the same to a stake with former location by allowing 2¹/₄° for variation S 88¹/₄° E 6¹/₄ ft. to a stone, S 82¹/₄° E 18¹/₄ ft. S 11¹/₄° E 12¹/₄ ft. S 76¹/₄° E 12¹/₄ ft. N 85¹/₄° E 16¹/₄ ft. N 14¹/₄° W 27¹/₄ ft. N 86¹/₄° W 30¹/₄ ft. to a stake and stones on the East side of a road thence with said road N 7¹/₄° W 4¹/₄ ft. to the place of beginning containing 5 A. 30¹/₂.
