The bill of Complaint of Daniel Stottenger,
of Frederick County, in the State of Maryland, respectfully represents, that about and during
the year Eighteen hundred and sixty one, a certain Nelson Stottenger died seized and
possessed of a certain tract of land lying and being in Frederick County aforesaid, called
"The Runway on Mount Height"; and containing twenty five and one fourth acres more
or less, which said land is described in Exhibit No 1 filed in this case and which Exhibit
your Orator prays may be taken and considered as part of this his bill of Complaint
and he further shows that the said Nelson Stottenger died intestate leaving a widow
named Hannah, since deceased, and twelve children, namely Jas. W. James C. Nelson W.
Daniel, William and Milton Stottenger, and Elizabeth, deceased, married to William
Hines, Mary J. married to Christian Harnum, Catharine, married to Arthur Land, Salu-
cia, married to George Harnum, Mahala, married to Moses L. Hurley, and Sarah Ann
married to Benjamin Shuff, all adults above the age of twenty one years, that Elizabeth
A. Hines has since died intestate, leaving the following children, Hannah C. James C.
Elizabeth A. Elija Amanda, Martha C. Hines, all infants under the age of twenty one
years and all residents of Frederick County aforesaid except Hannah C. Hines who resides
out of the State of Maryland, and in the State of Indiana to whom one twelfth interest
in said land descended, subject to the custody of said William Hines, husband of
