The object of this suit is to procure a decree for the sale of certain lands of which Nelson Stottenger late of Frederick County Maryland died seized and possessed.

The Bill states that sometime in the year 1841 a certain Nelson Stottenger died seized of certain real Estate described in the Bill and accompanying Exhibits.

That on the 24th day of March 1862, Christian Korman and Mary S his wife, George W. Stottenger and Rebecca his wife James C. Stottenger and Mary J his wife Nelson W. Stottenger and Sarah A. his wife, Daniel Stottenger and Mary his wife, William H. Stottenger and Amanda C. his wife, George Hainman and Sarah Ann, his wife, Arthur Lane and Catharine his wife, Moses S. Hurley and Malinda, his wife and Benjamin Shuff and Sarah, his wife, and Hannah Stottenger, widow of said Nelson Stottenger conveyed the aforesaid real Estate to Complainant except the interest of Elizabeth Hines dec'd, wife of William C. Hines one of the defendants - that Elizabeth S. Hines died intestate leaving the following children, namely, Hannah C. Samuel C. Elizabeth A. Eliza A. and Martha E. Hines who are infants and that the said Hannah C. Hines resides out of the State of Maryland. That the said real Estate is not susceptible of an advantageous division amongst the parties interested and that it would be to the advantage of all parties concerned, that the said real Estate should be sold and the proceeds thereof be distributed amongst the parties in proportion to their respective interests.

It is therefore ordered on this 28th day of November A.D. 1864 that the Complainant by causing a copy of this order to be inserted in some newspaper published at Frederick Maryland once in each of four successive weeks, before the 30th day of December A.D. 1864, give notice to the said absent defendants of the object and substance of this bill, and warn her to appear in this Court in person or by solicitor on or before the 30th day of March next to answer the premises and to show cause if any she has, why a decree ought not to pass as prayed.
