Best remembered that heretofore to wit on the 8th day of March 1861, came the said Joseph Smith's wife in Court here sitting, by Ulysses Krebs Solicitor and filed in Court here the following Bill and Exhibit. To the Hon. Madison Nelson Judge of the Circuit Court

for Frederick County, sitting as a Court of Equity.

The bill of Complaint of Joseph Smith and Catharine Smith of Frederick County and State of Maryland, humbly complaining sheweth unto your Honor, that heretofore to wit, sometime in August in the year Eighteen Hundred and fifty nine, a certain Garret Wolfe of the County and State aforesaid, died intestate and left certain real estate called "Warbaugh's Chance," which said estate of which the said Garret Smith died seized and possessed his and is situate in Frederick County and is particularly described in a deed of Conveyance from Christian Warbaugh to said Garret Smith dec'd, which said deed is herewith filed as a part of this bill, and prayer is to be taken and considered. And your Complainants further shew unto your Honor, that the said Garret Wolfe left no widow, but that his wife died some six or seven years before her husband. And your Complainants further shew that Garret Wolfe at the time of his death left the following Children and heirs at law to wit, Catharine, wife of Joseph Smith, one of the Complainants, who resides in Frederick County and State aforesaid, Elizabeth Wolfe who resides in the said County and State, John Wolfe who resides in the State of Ohio, Mary who married John Hoons, and who is now a widow and resides in the State of Pennsylvania, Samuel Wolfe who resides in the State of Virginia, Ann Wolfe who resides in the State of Pennsylvania, Daniel Wolfe, who resides in the State of Indiana, also William Wolfe who resided in the State of Virginia and Solomon Wolfe who resided in the State of Pennsylvania, of the two last mentioned heirs, it is not known to your orators, whether they are living or dead, or whether they left heirs, and your orators further shew unto your Honor, that all of the said Children and heirs are adults, and your orators humbly complaining further shew unto your Honor, that the said real estate of which the said Garret Wolfe died seized and possessed as aforesaid and which has
