

Fredrick County Maryland aforesaid to have and use as her own to sell and convey the same or to rent and receive the profits arising therefrom at her discretion. It is also my will that my said wife Nancy have the interest arising on all my Bonds, Notes and book accounts for her own use and disposal, so long as she is my widow, and after her decease or marriage - it is my will and desire that my Children Charles Wood, John Wood, Joseph Wood and Sarah Lock and their heirs, have all my Estate real and personal, then remaining share and share alike. - I do give and bequeath the Universalist Church and all such ground as is inclosed for a burying ground to the Universalist Society in the City of Baltimore, to have the management and control thereof for the benefit of the denomination where it is and to be kept up for the purpose for which it was first built and intended from time to time and all times, and further it is my desire and the true intent and meaning thereof that all my family and family connexions have the benefit of the Grave Yard if they or any of them should think proper to use it. - And as I have been keeping my sons from time to time more or less it is my will and desire that my daughter Sarah Lock aforesaid and her heirs have my Wood Lot near Mt. Eagles known by the name of Mount of Aze, it being the North end of said tract so called, which lot is to be addition to what has already been given to her, in the bequest with the rest of my Children and to have possession so soon as my decease. - It is my will and desire that my Executors hereinafter named shall receive my next Spring payment of George Guider and pay all my just debts, and also all the debts against my sons John Wood in which I am security, this being done in order as I can conceive to make my Children equal, and it is my will and intention that no debt or charges of mine against my Children shall be demanded or recovered but all to be considered as released. - And lastly I do hereby constitute and appoint my dear wife Nancy to be sole Executrix of this my last will and testament, revoking and annulling all former wills by me heretofore made, ratifying and confirming this and none other to be my last will and testament. - In testimony whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal this twenty third day of August in the year of our Lord one thousand Eight Hundred and forty nine. -
