

As it remembered that heretofore to wit: on the 14th day of July 1865, came the said Complainant in Court here sitting by W. J. and Chas. W. Rop Solicitor and filed in Court here the following Bill and Exhibits: 

In the Hon. Madison Nelson Circuit Judge of the fourth Judicial Circuit of the State of Maryland sitting in the Circuit Court for Frederick County as a Court of Equity

The Bill of Complaint of Peter Beard of Frederick County State of Maryland humbly shows to your Honor, that a certain Abraham Beard of Frederick County State of Maryland died intestate on or about the 20th day of June in the year Eighteen Hundred and sixty five, seized and possessed in fee simple in severalty and also as tenant in common of certain valuable real estate situate and being in the County and State aforesaid, being parts and parcels of the following described parts of tracts of land, viz: part of a tract of land called "Cattle Run", containing ten acres of land - conveyed to the said Abraham Beard by Jacob Stoop by deed dated on the 21st day of December in the year Eighteen Hundred and twenty two - all of which will fully and at large appear by reference to a certified copy of said deed herewith Exhibited marked Exhibit No. 1. - which together with all other Exhibits hereinafter produced your Complainant prays may be taken as part of this his bill of Complaint. -

Also part of a tract of land called "The Resurvey on Black Cat", situate and being in the County and State aforesaid - containing twelve acres and twenty two square perches of land sold and conveyed to the said Abraham Beard by John DeGrange Justice No 2091 Equity in the Circuit Court for Frederick County in Equity by deed dated on the 15th day of December in the year Eighteen Hundred and forty seven - all of which will appear by reference to a certified copy of said deed herewith Exhibited marked Exhibit No. 2. -

Also all that piece or parcel of land lying and being in the County and State aforesaid, being part of a tract of land called "Lambeth", containing one acre and twenty one perches of land more or less sold and conveyed to the said Abraham Beard by Laura E. Clagett by deed dated on the 17th day of April in the year Eighteen Hundred and fifty, all of which will appear by reference to a certified copy of said deed herewith Exhibited marked Exhibit No. 3. -

Also all those parts or part of tracts of land called "Deer Spring"; part of the "Resurvey on Mount Pleasant"; part of "Jones Conclusion"; and part or part of any other tract or tracts whatsoever being the same called or known by any other name containing one hundred and twenty acres, three rods and thirty six perches of land, situate and being in the County and State aforesaid which said land was sold and conveyed by John DeGrange Justice No 2091 Equity as aforesaid to the said Abraham Beard and Peter Beard, as tenants in common by deed dated on the 21st day of July in the year Eighteen Hundred and fifty - all of which will appear by reference to a certified copy of said deed herewith Exhibited marked Exhibit No. 4. -

Also all that tract or parcel of land situate and lying in the County and State aforesaid called "Kiss Lany"; also part of a tract of land called "Fielders" containing sixty six acres, one rood and 15¹/₄ perches of land - it being the estimated of said parts of tracts of land do and conveyed by a certain Francis J. Blessing and Henrietta W. Blessing his wife to certain John H. Renu by deed dated on the 6th day of March in the year Eighteen Hundred and sixty three, and the one half of said land described in the deed aforesaid sold and conveyed by the said John H. Renu and Sarah Ann R. Renu his wife to the said Abraham Beard, Peter Beard and Thomas C. Heister as tenants in common by deed dated on the ninth day of March in the year Eighteen
