The Bill of Complaint of Dennis W. Maynard of Carroll County respectfully sheweth unto your Honor that heretofore to wit, on the third day of February in the year Eighteen hundred and sixty, a certain John W. Strasberger of the County of Frederick, being indebted to your Orator in the sum of two hundred dollars by his single bill of said date payable twelve months after the date thereof with interest from date, did, for the purpose of securing the payment to your Orator of said sum of money with all legal interest thereon, by his deed of that date convey to your Orator certain real Estate lying in said County of Frederick and particularly described in said deed, to which said deed there is a condition annexed that it be void on the payment by said John W. Strasberger to your Orator of said sum of two hundred dollars in said single bill specified with interest thereon according to the tenor and effect of said single bill, as will fully appear by said single bill and deed of mortgage filed herewith marked respectively Exhibits No 1 and No 2, which with all other Exhibits your Orator prays may be taken as a part of this Bill of Complaint as if here inserted in words and figures ~ that afterwards, to wit on the 6th day of May in the year Eighteen hundred and sixty two, the said John W. Strasberger being indebted to your Orator in another sum of two hundred dollars by his single bill dated the day and year last aforesaid and payable on the first day of April in the year Eighteen hundred and sixty four with interest from the date thereof did, in order to secure the payment to your Orator of said sum of two hundred dollars in said last named single bill specified with all legal interest thereon, by his deed of the date of
