This Mortgage made this ninth day of August in the year one thousand Eight hundred and sixty two by John W. Strasburger of Annapolis, Frederick County Maryland, Witnesseth that in consideration of the sum of four hundred and ninety five dollars with interest thereof from the date hereof now due from the said John W. Strasburger to Ephraim Stone of the County and State aforesaid doth grant unto the said Ephraim Stone, all that lot and parcel of ground situated in Annapolis in the County and State aforesaid, Beginning for the same at a stone standing at the side of the public road running from Libertytown through Annapolis, which stone is on the East side of said road and which stone is at the end of 1/2 perch, North-Side; East from a certain stone now standing at the end of 29 3/4 feet, on the 18 line of a tract called 'Hingfield Delight'; and running thence by a line of Walter Meigs lot, South 69 deg: East 8 feet to a stone, then South 21 deg: West 9 1/2 feet to a stone, then North 69 deg: West 8 1/2 feet to the side of the aforesaid public road then with a straight line up said road to the first place of beginning containing seven sixteenths of an acre of land and 17 1/2 perches. ~ Provided that if the said John W. Strasburger shall pay on or before the first day of April in the year 1864, to the said Ephraim Stone the sum of four hundred and ninety five dollars with interest thereon from the date hereof according to the tenor of his promissory note of even date herewith, then this Mortgage shall be void. ~
