This Deed made this 18th day of February in the year 1862 by Samuel Wolfe and Barbara
Wolfe his wife of Frederick County in the state of Maryland, witnesses that in consideration
of the sum of nine hundred and thirty dollars, the said Samuel Wolfe and Barbara his wife
do grant unto John Warrnfeld of the County and State aforesaid, all that part of a tract or
parcel of land called "Seven Acre", lying in the County and State aforesaid, which is con-
tained within the following notes and bounds, courses and distances to wit: Beginning at a
stone planted at the beginning of the closing line of the 142 acre parcel of land
of land conveyed to said Samuel Wolfe by a certain Charles Miller by deed dated the 18th of Feb-
-ruary 1862 and running thence North 87 deg. West 35 ft. to the original beginning thereof, then
North 55 deg. West 16 ft. North 8 deg. West 9 ft. South 85 deg. West 49 ft. to the public road, then
with said road North 14 deg. East 7 ft. North 1 deg. West 32 ft. then leaving said road South 89
deg. East 35 ft. to a chestnut tree, North 56 deg. East 16 ft. South 84 deg. East 5 ft. South 4
