 Court of Equity. The Bill of Complaint of Lawsom A Moam and Martha M his wife, Sarah }
 Moam and Amanda his wife, Henry Biser and Mary E his wife, Joshua A Moam, Charles }
 Hoogbe and Amanda C. his wife, and Susan A B. Moam, shows That a certain Frederick Moam }
 late of Frederick County, State of Maryland, died intestate on or about the twenty fourth day of May }
 1863, leaving a widow, Elizabeth Moam, and leaving the following children, his heirs at law, }
 to wit, - a son, Sarah Moam married to Amanda Bowler, a daughter, Mary Elizabeth }
 Moam, married to Henry Biser, a son Joshua A Moam, a daughter Amanda Charlotte }
