

said Frederick Mann during his lifetime - Your Complainants further state that the said Frederick Mann at the time of his death, was seized and possessed of a right or rights of way over certain pieces or parts of tracts of land called "Oakland Mills" "Rifle Run" "Great Ground-shed" or by whatsoever names the same may be called or known, situate in Frederick County State of Maryland, which rights of way are described in copies of a deed from James Hanna and wife to Frederick Mann, and of a deed from Daniel Bess and wife to Frederick Mann, herewith exhibited and marked Exhibit No. 3 and Exhibit No. 4. - Your Complainants further state that the said Frederick Mann, at the time of his death, was seized in fee of other certain pieces or parts of tracts of land called "Arabic", "Cherry Chase" "Shadows Creek" "Brose Hill" "In war a Tory in peace a rebel" "The old story over again" "The Memory of Cherry Chase" or by whatsoever names the same may be called or known, situate in Frederick County State of Maryland, containing one hundred and eight acres more or less which pieces or parts of tracts of land are described in a copy of the deed from John Burr to Frederick Mann herewith exhibited and marked Exhibit No. 5. Your complainants further state that the said Frederick Mann, at the time of his death, was seized in fee of a house and lot, situate in the west end of Brice's addition to Middletown in Frederick County, State of Maryland, described in a ^{copy of the} deed from Joseph Miso, Trustee, and Elizabeth Miso to Frederick Mann, herewith exhibited and marked Exhibit No. 6 also of a certain other piece of land, situate in said County and State, adjoining said House and lot, described in a copy of the deed from Joseph Miso and wife to Frederick Mann herewith exhibited and marked Exhibit No. 7 - Your Complainants further state that the said lands, tenements & hereditaments, which descended to them and the infant Lauretta C Mann, are not susceptible of partition without loss or injury to the parties interested, and that it will be to the advantage and benefit of the infant as well as a adult heirs that the same be sold under the order and decree of the Court, and the proceeds of sale divided among the parties interested according to their respective rights. - And your Complainants who are the only adult heirs agree that the said real estate may be sold by a decree of this Court for the purposes of partition, waiving a Commission to view value, and all rights of election. - It is the end therefore that the said Lauretta C Mann, the infant defendant, may, by guardian to be appointed according to the usage and practice of this Court, answer the premises, - and that a decree may be passed for the sale of the said land and premises, and the proceeds of sale thereof distributed amongst the parties interested in proportion to their respective rights, and that your Complainants may have such other and further relief in the premises as the nature and equity of their case may require. - Now it please your Honor to grant unto your Complainants the writ of subpoena against the said Lauretta C Mann, commanding her to be and appear in this Court, at some certain day to be therein named, to answer the premises and abide by and perform such decree as may be passed thereon, and your Complainants will soer pray &c.

This Indenture made this first day of April in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and thirty six, between Peter Michael of Frederick County, in the State of Maryland, of the one part and Frederick Mann of the County and State aforesaid of the other part, Witnesseth, that the said Peter Michael for and in consideration of the sum of six thousand four hundred and thirty five dollars current money of the United States to him in hand paid by the said Frederick Mann before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof he the said Peter Michael doth hereby acknowledge, have granted, bargained, sold, aliened, conveyed and confirmed and
