At the request of Frederick Mann Jr. the following was recorded January 25th 1848 —

The Indenture made this 4th day of June in the year of our Lord One thousand Eight hundred and forty seven between James Kinna and Elizabeth Kinna his wife of Frederick County in the State of Maryland of the first part and Frederick Mann Jr. of the County and State aforesaid of the other part Witnesses, that the said James Kinna and Elizabeth Kinna his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of One hundred and seventy five dollars current money to them well paid by the said Frederick Mann Jr. before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof they do hereby acknowledge, have granted, bargained, sold, aliened, conveyed, and confirmed, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell, alien, convey and confirm unto the said Frederick Mann Jr. his heirs and assigns for the use and purpose of a road and for no other purpose use or intent whatsoever except that of a road for the use of the farms on which said Mann now resides, All that part of a tract of Land or parts of tracts of land lying and being in the County and State aforesaid. The same being part of a tract of Land called "Oak Land Mills" and part of a tract of land called "Hills Run". Beginning for the outlines of the part hereby intended to be conveyed by these, at a stone at the end of a line of "Oak Land Mills" as it was surveyed on the 10th day of June 1832 for 255 1/4 acres, the same being at the end of the last line of a tract of Land called "Small Meadow" and the same being planted and standing on the 1st line of a tract of Land called "Great Friendship", running then North twenty degrees West 7/10 perches, or two feet; South Eighty two degrees and 1/2 a degree West forty eight perches and half a perch to intersect the 19th line of Michael's land at the end of 79 1/2 perches from the beginning, then with said line South one half degree West 16 1/10 perches to the beginning of said 19th line North 45 degrees East 7 1/2 perches to a stone marked A to the North 43 1/2 degrees East 17 perches to a stone standing on the South side of Mann's road, then North 82 1/2 degrees East 30 7/10 perches to the first mentioned beginning, containing one acre and eleven square perches of land. Together with all and singular the buildings, improvements, hereditaments and appurtenances whatsoever thereto belonging or in any wise appertaining and the reversions and remainders, rents and issues and
