At the request of Philip Hammond the following Deed was recorded April 10th 1857.

This Deed made this first day of April in the year of our Lord One thousand Eight hundred and Fifty seven by William W. Walker, and Mary E. Walker his wife, Frederick County and State of Maryland, Witnesses, that for and in consideration of the sum of seven thousand three hundred dollars to them in hand paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the said William W. Walker and Mary E. Walker his wife doth grant unto Philip Hammond of the County and State aforesaid all the following part of a Tract of Land called "Norris Purchase", Situated lying and being in Frederick County and State aforesaid. Beginning for the outline thereof at the original beginning of said Tract called "Norris Purchase", it being a planted stone marked B, and running thence by and with the outlines thereof by a correction of one degree for variation to correspond with its former location, South twenty three and a half degrees East fifty seven and three fourth perches to a stone planted and marked S. on the West side and N on the East side at the end of Eighty eight perches on the Thirty second line of that tract of Land called "The Resurvey on Hall Choice" granted to Benjamin Hall in November 1782 for Eight hundred and twenty four acres, as formerly run and fixed then South sixty two degrees East sixty four perches to a stone planted and marked on the West side W and on the East side E North seventy one degrees East one hundred and thirteen perches to a stone now planted and marked on the West side S on the East side I then leaving the outlines, North Eight and a half degrees, West Ninety one perches to a stone planted and marked on the West side S on the East side I and on the North side E. South seventy nine and three fourth degrees West, West one hundred and forty four tenth perches to a stone formerly planted in the given line of said Tract of Land called "Norris Purchase", thence and with said given line to the beginning, containing One hundred acres of acres of land more or less, being the same part of a Tract of Land conveyed to William W. Plummer by Joel Norris, and Rachel Norris his wife bearing date July twenty ninth One Thousand Eight hundred and Forty five, and recorded in Liber W. D. S. No 2 folio 374 &c. one of the Land Records of Frederick County, and by William W. Plummer and Harriet S. Plummer his wife to William W. Walker bearing date first day of April One Thousand Eight hundred and Fifty seven. Witness our hand and seal.
