

20th day of November 1866 ordered that the Complainants by causing a copy of this order to be inserted in some newspaper published in Frederick's County at least once a week for four successive weeks before the twenty eighth of December eighteen hundred and sixty six, give notice to said absent defendant of the object and substance of this Bill, and warn him to appear in this Court in person or by solicitor on or before the first day of April 1867, to answer the premises and to show cause if any why a decree ought not to pass as prayed.

This Indenture made this twenty first day of March in the year four thousand eight hundred and forty eight between Charles Shriver and Ann C. Shriver his wife of Frederick's County in the State of Maryland of the one part and Andrew Michael of the said County and State of the other part Witnesses, that for and in consideration of the sum of three hundred and fifty seven dollars and forty seven cents current money by the said Andrew Michael to the said Charles Shriver and Ann C. Shriver his wife in hand paid, at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof they do hereby acknowledge and themselves to be therewith fully satisfied, contented and paid, the said Charles Shriver and Ann C. his wife, have bargained and sold aliened and enfeoffed, and by these presents do give, grant, bargain and sell, alien enfeoff release convey and confirm unto the said Andrew Michael, his heirs and assigns, all the following described piece or parcel of ground lying and being in the County aforesaid it being part of a tract of land called "Hill in the Middle", Beginning for the part of said tract hereby intended to be conveyed, at the end of the second line of a tract of land called "Leonard's Beginning" and running thence with the third line thereof East eighteen perches to a planted stone, then South nine and a half degrees West sixty nine and three fourths perches to intersect the twelfth line of the whole tract aforesaid called "Hill in the Middle" then with said twelfth line reversed North fifty eight degrees West seventy three and six tenths perches to the end of the eleventh line thereof, still with the outlines of said whole tract reversed, two courses, North forty one and one fourth degrees East four inches, North fifty eight degrees West fifty one and seven tenths perches to the forty second line of a tract of land called "Hoskins' Choice" then with said land North twelve degrees East twelve and one fourth perches to the end of the twelfth line of one hundred and sixty eight and one fourth acres part of said tract called "Hill in the Middle" which was allotted to Otho Thomas as in a deed of partition between the said Otho Thomas and Nolley Thomas dated the eighth day of May eighteen hundred and twenty six and running thence with the lines of said deed four courses and distances, to wit, South sixty three and three fourth degrees East thirty five perches, South seventy four degrees East twenty and one half perches, North seventy four degrees East twenty six perches, North seventy seven and a half degrees East nineteen and three fourths perches to the first mentioned place of beginning containing twenty three acres, three roods and thirteen square perches of land more or less, together with all and singular the buildings improvements, ways, waters, rights, members, privileges, advantages and appurtenances thereto belonging or in any wise appertaining, and all the estate, right, title, and interest, trust property, claims and demands whatsoever at law and in Equity, of them, the said Charles Shriver and Ann C. his wife of in and to the same, To have and to hold the said herein described premises, with the appurtenances thereunto belonging unto the said Andrew Michael his heirs and
