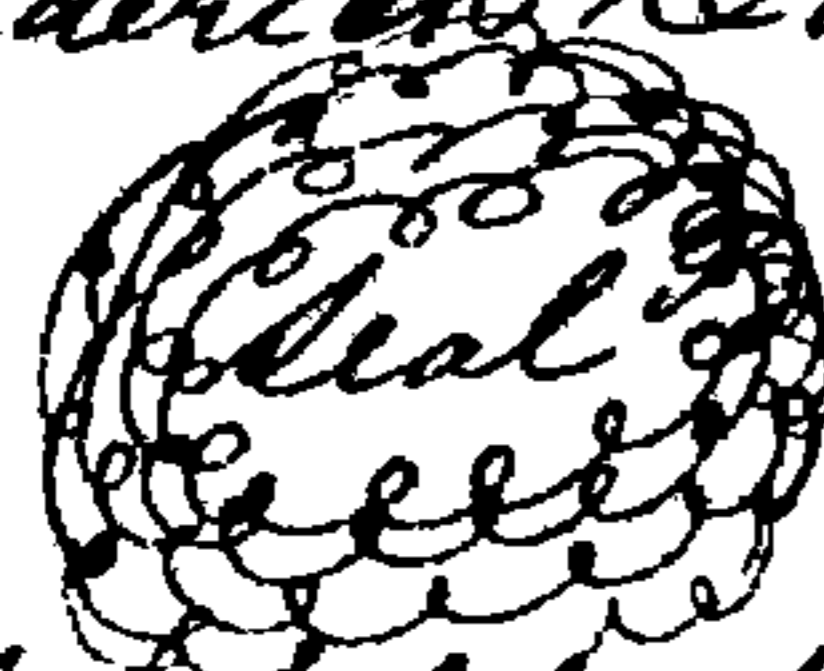

 the following articles of personal property viz. One Book Store, one parlor stove, fifty  
 yards of rag Carpet together with every other article of personal property now in the  
 possession of the said Barrick, together with the real estate owned by the said Barrick, in-  
 cluding a house and lot in Middletown, which was particularly described in a deed re-  
 corded in Liber B & F No. 10 folio 279 &c one of the Land Records of Frederick County. Provided  
 that if the said Levi Barrick Jr. shall pay the sum above mentioned, with the interest  
 thereon at the time when due, then this Mortgage shall be void.

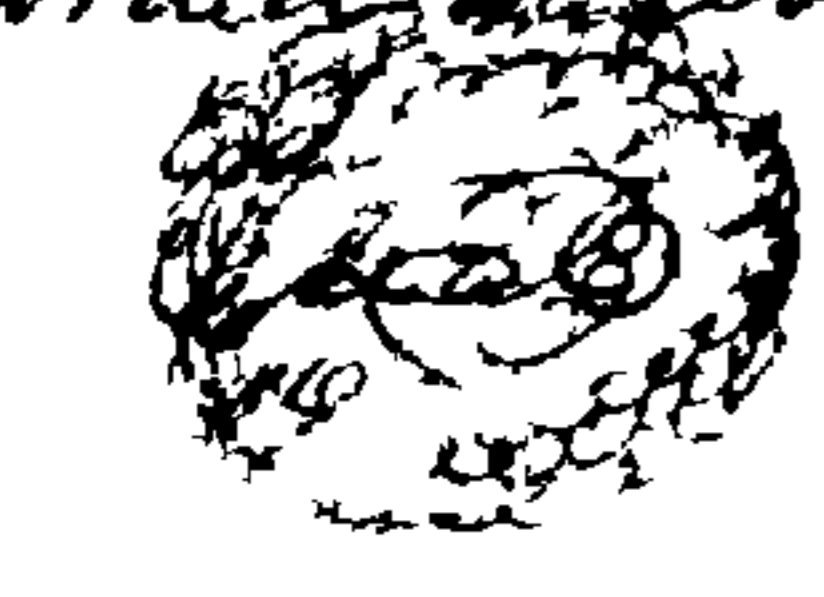
