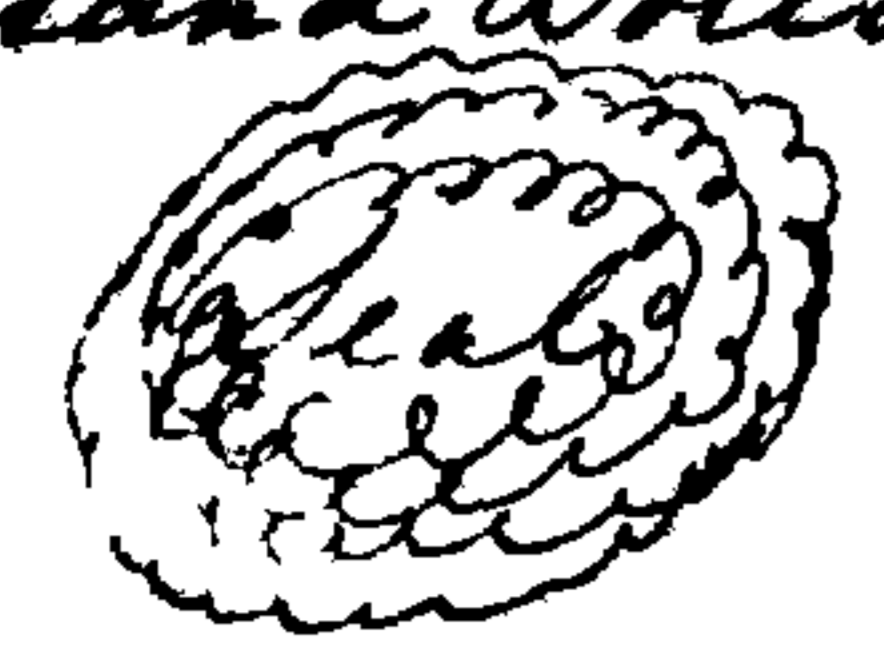

At the request of Levi Barrick for the following Mortgage was recorded November 11th 1858 ~

This Mortgage made this 27th day of October in the year Eighteen hundred and fifty eight by Levi Barrick for Witnesseth, that in consideration of a note of hand for five Hundred Dollars, with interest thereon from the date hereof and payable to Levi Barrick Sr or order, on the tenth day of November 1858 doth grant unto the said Levi Barrick Sr all that lot and parcel of ground together with the buildings thereon situated and lying in Middletown, and being the same lot and parcel of ground which was conveyed by Levi Barrick Sr. and wife to Levi Barrick Jr by deed bearing date the 7th day of April 1857. and recorded in Liber C. & S. No 11 folio 269 & 270 one of the Land Records of Frederick County. Provided that if the said Levi Barrick Jr shall pay on or before the first day of July in the year Eighteen hundred and fifty nine to the Levi Barrick Sr the sum of Five Hundred Dollars with interest thereon from the date hereof according to the tenor of his promissory note of even date herewith. then this Mortgage shall be void. And the said Levi Barrick Jr covenants that he will pay the aforesaid money, and he further covenants that in default of payment, the said Levi Barrick Sr. may enter. Provided, that until default of payment the said Levi Barrick Jr shall possess the premises, and provided that if default shall be made in the payment of the money aforesaid or the interests thereon at the time or in the manner aforesaid then it shall be lawful for the said Levi Barrick Sr to sell the said Mortgaged premises at Middletown by public Auction for cash after giving at least three weeks public notice of the time, place, manner and terms of sale, in one or more newspapers published in Frederick County at least once a week for three successive weeks prior to the day of sale, to pay the debt, and the surplus if any over to the said Levi Barrick Jr

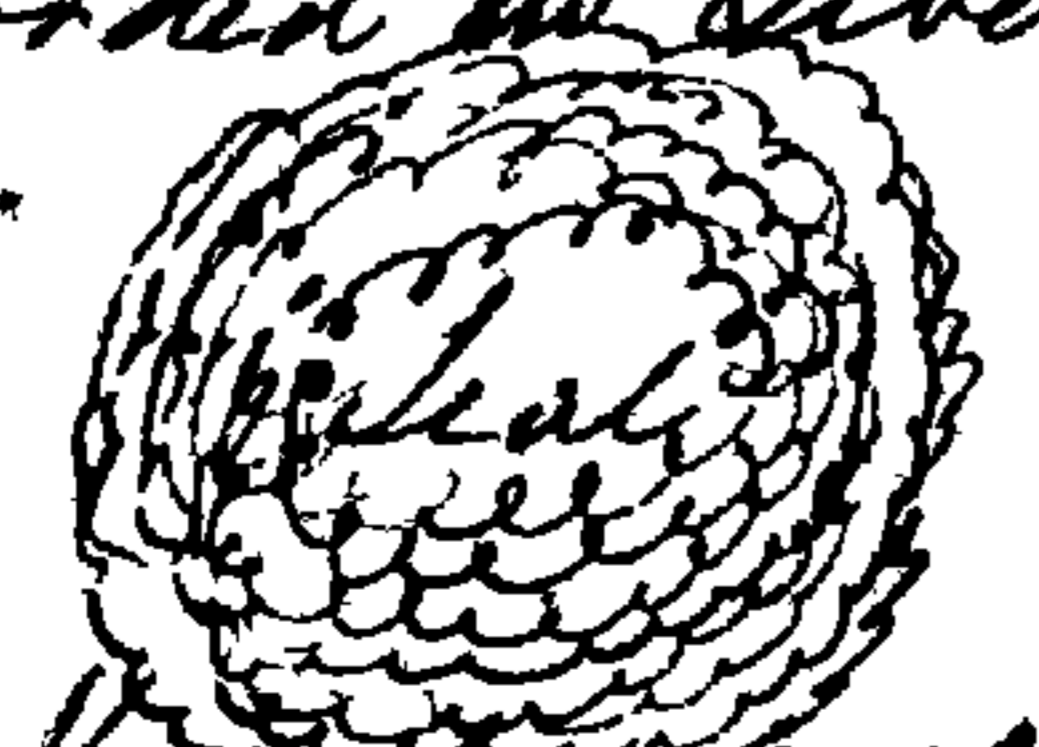
