 July Term 1866 ~
 The Bill as amended states that since filing the original Bill, the Complainants have discovered, and charge that Levi Barrecks Sr has assigned his Mortgage Claim to Elizabeth Barrecks, and that Levi Barrecks Jr has conveyed his Equity of redemption to said Elizabeth Barrecks. It is thereupon this 9th day of October 1866 ordered that the Complainants by causing a copy of this order to be inserted in some newspaper, published in Frederick once in each of four successive weeks before the 12th day of November next, give notice to said absent defendant Levi Barrecks Jr of the effect and substance of this Bill and warn him to appear on this Court in person or by solicitor on or before the 18th day of February 1867 to answer the premises, and show cause, if any he have, why a Decree should not pass as prayed ~
