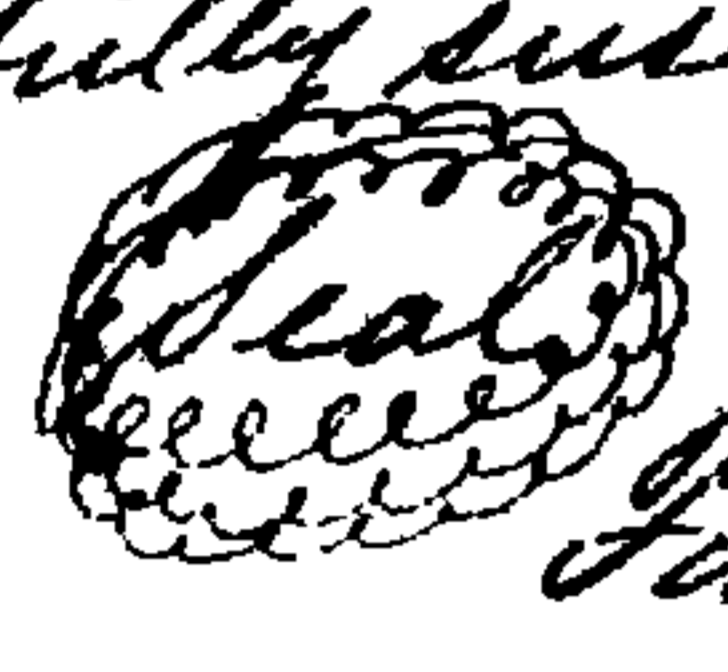


Answer of

This defendant for answer to said Bill of Complaint, answers and says - That it admits that Exhibits filed in said Bill are true copies of the Mortgages referred to in said Bill & This defendant further admits that Levi Barrick with Wm Hersperger and William J. Brown as his securities executed the note for Five Hundred Dollars referred to in Exhibit No. 2 That your respondent recovered judgment on said note at October Term 1860 of the Circuit Court for Frederick County, which judgment is still due and unpaid, That interest thereon has been paid by Elizabeth Barrick the owner of said mortgaged premises until January 15th 1861. & This respondent further admits that the note intended to be secured by Exhibit No. 3, has been satisfied by the securities named therein. & Your respondent has no knowledge of the other matters and things stated in said Bill of Complaint without this, &c and this respondent prays hence to be dismissed with its reasonable costs and charges in this behalf wrongfully sustained. & Witness the corporate seal of the Frederick Town Savings Institution

To the Honorable Madison Nelson Judge of the Circuit Court for Frederick County sitting as a Court of Equity & The Amended Bill of Complaint of the Calvert Savings Institution of said County respectfully shows to your Honor that your Orator on the 23rd day of March in the year 1860, filed this Bill of Complaint in this Court against The Frederick Town Savings Institution, William Hersperger, William J. Brown, Peter Meliard, Levi Barrick Jr and Levi Barrick Sr., praying amongst other things for the sale of certain real estate mortgaged by said Levi Barrick Jr to said William Hersperger and William J. Brown, as is particularly set forth in said Bill of Complaint, to which Bill the Defendants, the Frederick Town Savings Institution, and Levi Barrick Sr answered, as by the proceedings in said case No. 3298 on the Docket of said Court, which is to be taken as a part of this Bill, will appear. Your Orator have lately discovered, and now charge by way of amendment to their aforesaid Bill of Complaint that the said Levi Barrick Sr. has assigned and transferred to his daughter Elizabeth Barrick the Mortgage debt secured by Exhibit No. 3, and that Levi Barrick Sr. was conveyed all his interest in said real estate to his sister, the said Elizabeth Barrick, who is therefore a necessary party to this suit, as will appear by said deed, a copy of which is filed herewith as Exhibit No. 6. To the end therefore that the said Frederick Town Savings Institution and Levi Barrick Sr. may answer this amendment and
