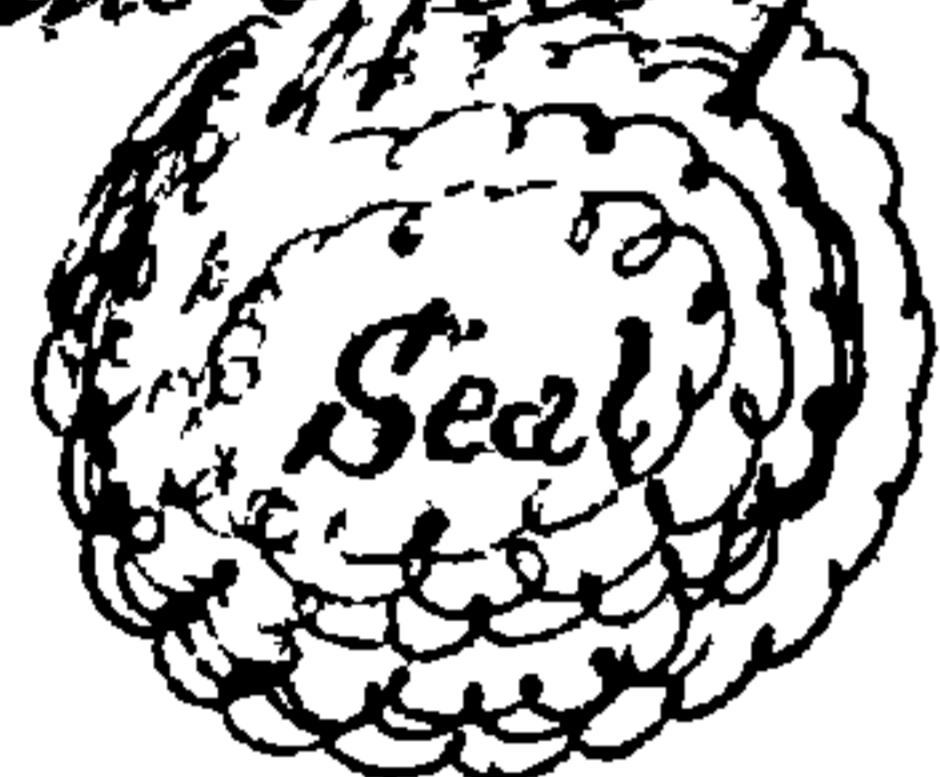

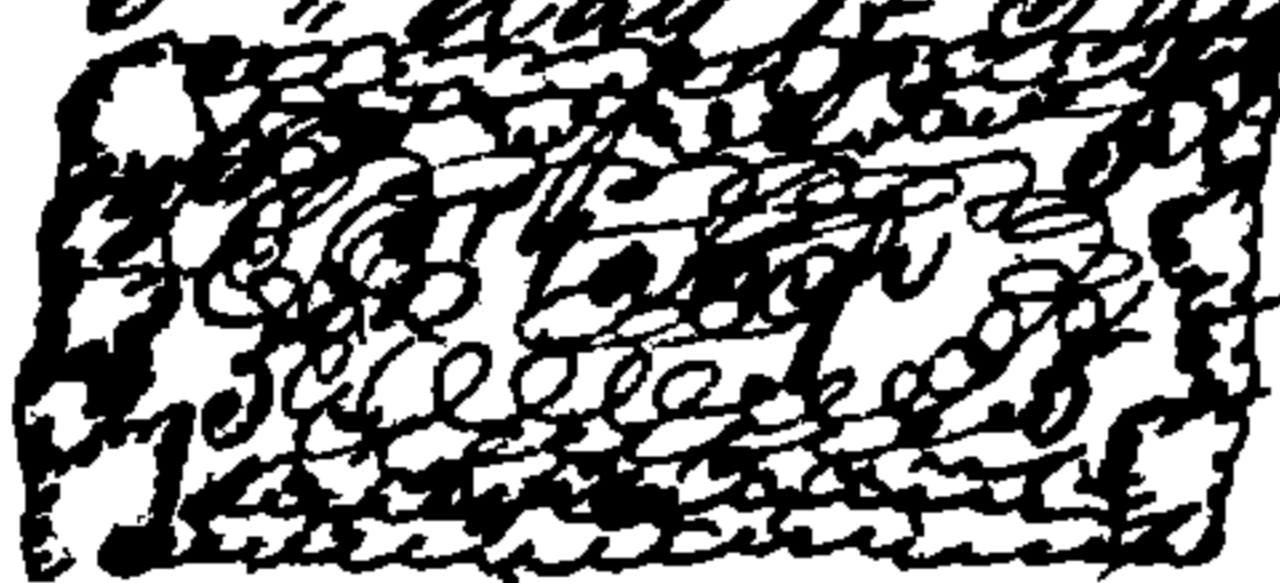

This Defendant for answer to said Bill of Complaint, answers and says that she admits the several matters and things stated in said Bill, to be true as therein stated, and this defendant as widow of said Joseph W^o Carty deceased covenants and agrees that the real estate therein mentioned shall be sold under a decree of this Court, free and discharged from her right of Dower in said real estate, such proportion of the purchase money as is allowed by rules of your Honorable Court to widows consenting to sales of their dower right.
