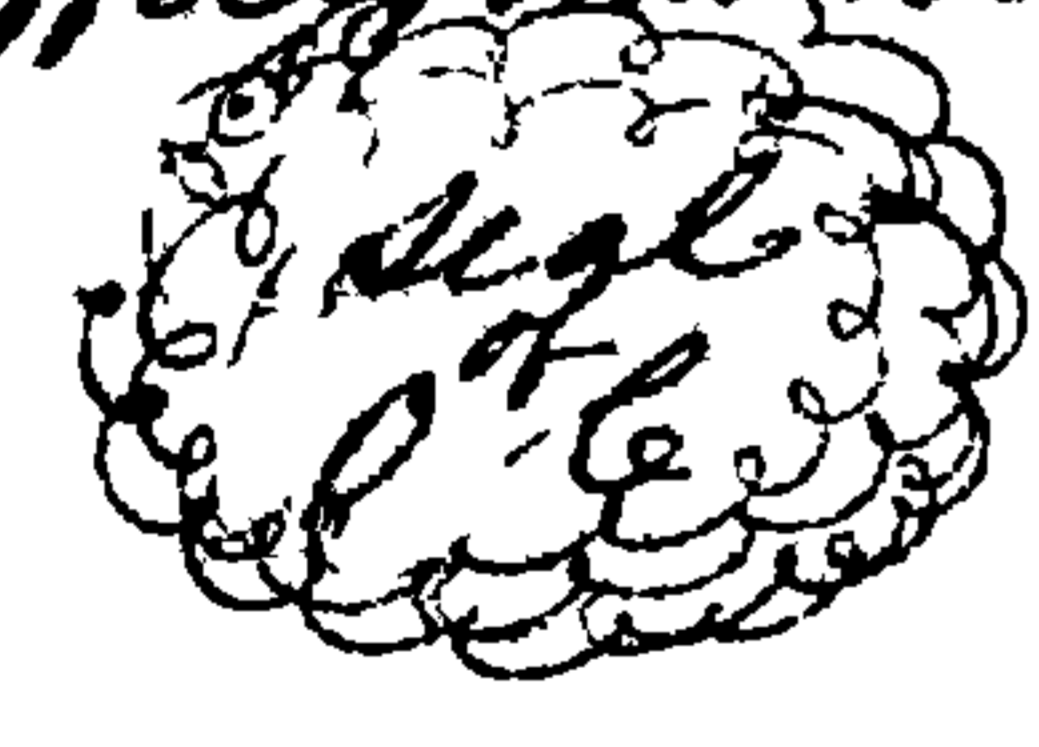

Clarence C. Carty by John C. Hardt his next friend
vs
Charles P. Carty and others
No. 3352 Equity
In the Circuit Court for Frederick County sitting as a Court of Equity.
July Term 1867
The above cause standing ready for a hearing, and being submitted, the Bill, Answers, Exhibits, Depositions and all other proceedings were by the Court read and considered. It is thereupon this 7th day of August in the year Eighteen hundred and sixty seven by the Honorable Madison Nelson, Circuit Judge for the Fourth Judicial Circuit of the State of Maryland, and by the authority of the Circuit Court for Frederick County, as a Court of Equity, adjudged, ordered, and decreed, that the land and premises mentioned in these proceedings be sold and that William S. Ross of Frederick County be, and he is hereby appointed a Trustee to make the said sales, and that the course and manner of his proceeding shall be as follows: He shall file in the Clerk's office of this Court a bond to the State of Maryland executed by himself with a surety, or sureties, to be approved by the Court, or the Clerk thereof, in the penalty of Ten Thousand Dollars, conditioned for the faithful performance of the trust reposed in him by this Decree, or which may be reposed in
