In the Circuit Court for Frederick County as a Court of Equity,
February Term 1856

It is therefore ordered this 27th day of February 1856 that George
W. Souder of said County, be and he is hereby appointed Trustee to take charge of the property
and person of the Lunatic mentioned in this cause; He shall first file with the Office of the
Clerk of said Court, a bond to the State of Maryland, executed by himself with a surety or sureties
to be approved by the Court in the penalty of ten thousand dollars conditioned for the faithful
performance of the trust reposed in him by this order, or which may be reposed in him, by any
future order or decree in the premises and to deliver up the property of the said Lunatic when
ever he may be required by the Court, and to render an account of all his receipts and expenditures
as trustee once in each year and oftener if required; and upon filing the above bond with the
conditions of this order, the said Trustee shall be and he is hereby authorized to take charge
of the property and person of the said Lunatic
