The petition of John A. Lynch respectfully shows unto your Honor that at the instance and request of a certain James Greene, your petitioner in the name of said Greene filed a bill in Equity on the 2<sup>d</sup> day of September Anno Domini 1864 (No 3184 Equity in said Court) for the sale of certain real estate in said County; that while said bill was pending and undecided the said Greene employed Wm J. and Chas W. Pop Esqs. to file the bill in this cause for the sale of the said real estate; that a decree has been passed in this cause for the sale of said real estate, and the said Charles W. Pop Esq has been appointed Trustee, and has sold the same, that the sale has been ratified, and this cause has been referred to the auditor to state an account.
