 of this suit, respectfully sheweth to your Honor that the said Adam Butter in his lifetime
 was indebted unto Peter Shafer by his two promissory notes bearing interest, for the respec-
 tive amounts of seventy five and thirty six dollars upon both of which your Orator acted as secur-
 ity for the said Adam Butter, all of which will more fully appear by reference to said prom-
 issory notes filed herewith as Exhibits No 1 and 2, which with all other Exhibits your Orator prays
 may be taken as a part of this his bill of complaint as if here inserted in words and figures. ~
 Your Orator further sheweth to your Honor that the said Adam Butter died intestate sometime
 in the fall of the year Eighteen hundred and sixty three without having paid to the said
 Peter Shafer the full amount of principal and interest due upon said notes, and your Orator
 as surety on the fifth day of January in the year Eighteen hundred & sixty four paid to the
 Peter Shafer the balance due thereon, amounting to one hundred & thirteen dollars eighty seven
 cents, as will appear by reference to said Exhibits 1 and 2, Your Orator further sheweth unto your
 Honor that the said Adam Butter dead was also indebted unto your Orator to the amount of
