Buffington may answer the premises and that a decree may be passed for a sale of the aforesaid land and the proceeds of sale may be distributed among the parties entitled to the same and that your complainants may have such further or other relief in the premises as their case may require may it please your Honor to grant to your complainant the writ of Subpoena against the said William C. Buffington and Alexander A. Buffington of Frederick County Commanding them to appear in this Court by a certain day to be therein named to answer the premises and abide by and perform such decree as may be passed therein and your complainants will ever praye

This Indenture made this twenty third day of May in the year of Our Lord 1848 between Gerratt D and Matilda Warfield and Jacob and Sarah Stites of Frederick County and State of Maryland of the one part and Alexander Buffington of the County of Dauphin in State of Pennsylvania of the other part Witnesseth that the said parties of the first part for and in consideration of the sum of three thousand current money of the United States, to them in hand paid by the said Alexander Buffington before the signing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof they the said parties of the first part do hereby acknowledge have granted bargained sold aliened conveyed and confirmed and by these presents do grant bargain sell alien convey and confirm unto the said party of the second part his heirs and assigns all the following
