

Petition + Report of County sitting in Equity. The Petition and further report of
 E. J. Herb & others 2768 on the Docket of your Honorable Court respectfully states
 that on the 10th day of March last past Josiah Thomas the
 purchaser mentioned in their report of sale made in said
 Cause paid to them the sum of \$11,980.73 on account of said
 purchase money and that on the 30th day of same month
 the said purchaser paid to them the entire balance of said
 purchase money and interest to said day and that on said
 10th day of March your petitioners paid to Robert Borne
 the agent of Charles I. Canale the sum of \$1198.73 the amount
 of the principal and interest of a note herewith filed mar
 ked A. B. and that on said 30th day of March they paid
 to James Dutton the assignee of and the note payable
 by James Castle the defendant in said Cause to said
 Charles I. Canale herewith filed marked C. D. the amount
 of the principal & interest of said note and that on the same
 day they paid to said Josiah & Thomas the amount of
 the principal & interest of a similar note assigned to said
 Thomas herewith filed marked A. S. J. which said three notes
 were secured by a Judgment Confessed by said James Castle
 to said Charles I. Canale on the 11th day of August 1853 as
 will appear from a Copy of said judgment herewith filed
 marked C. J. C. and were liens on said land pursuant to the
 mortgage mentioned in the Bill & proceedings in said Cause
 N^o 2768. And also that on said 30th day of March they paid
 to James Dutton the amount of the principal & interest due
 on the note mentioned in said Bill & proceedings in said
 Cause as due to & in the possession of said Dutton as will
 appear from said note & the receipt thereon indorsed herewith
 filed marked C. D. N^o 2 and also that they paid to said
 Dutton the amount of costs in a suit which he had instituted
 on said note as will appear from the receipt therefor
 herewith filed marked C. D. N^o 3 all which said several pay
 ments they pray may be allowed to them out of said pur
 chase money in as much as each of them were entitled to
 a share of payment out of the proceeds of sale of the lands
 mentioned in the Bill & proceedings in said Cause and
 were only paid by your petitioners pursuant to the statute &
 ratification of an Order in said Cause for the purpose of
 saving the accrue of further interest thereon and they
 further state that on said 30th day of March your petitioners
 who were the Complainants in said Cause appropriated
 to the payment of the monies due from said Castle to
 themselves the amounts mentioned in the said Bill of
 Complaint to have been paid by them to the Freedmen's
 Loan Savings Institution and to Jacob Specht and
