This Indenture made this nineteenth day of October in the year one thousand eight hundred and thirty five between George Brown of Maryland County in the State of Maryland of the one part and William Brown Jr of the County and State aforesaid of the other part it is covenanted that the said George Brown for and in consideration of eighteen hundred dollars current money to him in hand paid before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof he the said George Brown doth hereby acknowledge hath granted bargained sold aliened released conveyed and confirmed and by these presents doth grant bargain sell alien release convey and confirm unto him the said William Brown Senior his heirs and assigns forever all that tract or parcel of land lying and being in County and State aforesaid being part of the Resurvey of Round Meadow and Stone Enough beginning for said part at the end of fifty perches on the fourth line of the part of said Resurvey on Round Meadow and Stone Enough and thence running with the outlines of the same S 80° East 40 ps S 24° W 12 1/4 ps S 60° E 40 ps N 85° E 100 ps S 19° E 50 ps S 11° W 100 ps N 82° W 82 ps S 18° E 35 ps S 68° W 18 1/4 ps then running the division line between Tobias Pitters part and this part as follows N 20° W 120 ps N 7 1/4 ps N 21° W 108 ps to the place of beginning containing one hundred & sixty five acres of land more or less the said aforesaid land surveyed for John Biggs on the 28th day of November 1792 and now called the Separation also all that part of parcel of land being part of a tract called the Separation being a vacancy added thereto by John Biggs beginning for said part at the end of the seventh line of the whole tract called the Separation and running thence with the 8" line thereof S 23° W 39 ps to the end of the first line of the part of Stone Enough included in an original by said Resurvey and with it reverse N 18° W 30 ps to the beginning of said part then S 82° E 37 ps to the first
