To the Hon^{ble} Madam Nelson Circuit Judge for
the third Judicial Circuit of the State of Maryland
sitting in the Circuit Court for Frederick County
in Equity. The Bill of Complaint of Stephen Ramsburg
of Frederick County State of Maryland respectfully
sheweth, that Stephen Ramsburg late of Frederick
County State of Maryland deceased by his last
will and testament duly executed to pass real estate
devised to your Complainant and the sisters of your
Complainant Susanna Rebecca and Catharine as
tenants in Common the plantation on which the said
testator then dwelled known as part of a tract called
Mortality being part of a tract of land called
Taskers Chance & containing about two hundred
acres of land and a Mountain lot called Chestnut
Hill containing about fifty acres of land more
or less situate in the County and State aforesaid
as will appear by a Copy of said will herewith
exhibited marked Exhibit No 1 which your Complain
ant prays may be taken as a part of this his
Bill of Complaint together with all other Exhibits
herewith exhibited your Complainant further states
that after the death of said testator the devisees
therein named occupied said lands as tenants
in Common that Rebecca Ramsburg and Catharine
Ramsburg two of the devisees after the death of said
testator died intestate and without issue and
that the whole title interest and estate in said
lands vested in your Complainant and his sister
Susanna Ramsburg as tenants in Common. Your
Complainant further states that the said Susanna Ram
sburg died in the month of July in the year 1858 having
