Mitchell late of Frederick & formerly of Kent County in the State of Maryland & look at the paper now shown me marked Exhibit A N^o 1 the signature thereon is in the handwriting of said M^{rs} Ann M. Mitchell The body of the note is in my handwriting and any impression is that the note was signed by M^{rs} Ann M. Mitchell in my presence. In the 3rd Interrogatory I look at the paper here shown me marked B N^o 2 the body of said paper is in my handwriting of said Ann M. Mitchell In the 4th Interrogatory M^{rs} Ann M. Mitchell is dead she died in the month of January 1853 she left Joseph J. Mitchell as her only child In the 5th Interrogatory M^{rs} Ann M. Mitchell died intestate leaving for said son Joseph J. Mitchell as her only heir at Law. In the 6th Interrogatory Joseph J. Mitchell of Frederick County is a son of said Ann M. Mitchell & her sole heir
