 of Almighty God that they will according to the best  
 of their skill and judgment make the partition as  
 directed by the foregoing Commission and in all things  
 truly and faithfully execute the powers given and  
 perform the duties required of them by the said Com-  
 mission without favor or partiality to or prejudice, or ill  
 will against any person whatever interested therein
