This Indenture made the 28th day September Anno Domini 1854 between William Shuman and Sarah Ann Shuman his wife of the one part and James Renna of the other part all of Frederick County in the state of Maryland Witnesseth that for and in Consideration of the sum three hundred dollars Current money by the said James Renna to the said William Shuman and Sarah Ann Shuman his wife in hand paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt of which they do hereby acknowledge the said William Shuman and Sarah Ann Shuman his wife have bargained, and sold aliened and conveyed and by these presents do give grant bargain and sell aliened convey release confirm and confirm unto the said James Renna his husband a piece of that part of a tract or parcel of land situate lying and being in the County and state aforesaid Beginning for the same at the end of five perches on the fifteenth line of the farm called "Clifton" conveyed by James Hidding and wife to William Hidding and running thence with said line South 2 1/2 degrees East 20 perches then South 78 1/2 degrees West fifteen perches and five tenths of a perch thence North 20 1/2 degrees West 17 perches and 7/10 of a perch thence South 80 degrees East 8 perches thence North 61 degrees East 14 perches and 3/10 of a perch to the place of beginning containing one acre three Rods and
