 This Indenture made this 24th day of June in the year
 of our Lord 1848 by & between Israel Ransburg and
 Deborah Ransburg his wife of Frederick County and
 State of Maryland of the first part and James Kenna
 of the County and State aforesaid of the second part
 Witnesseth that the said Israel Ransburg & Deborah
 his wife aforesaid for and in consideration of the
 sum of eight hundred dollars Current money to
 them in hand paid at and before the sealing and
 delivery of these presents the receipt whereof they do
 hereby acknowledge have granted bargained & sold
 aliened conveyed released conveyed and confirmed
 and by these presents do grant bargain and sell
 alien convey release convey and confirm unto him
 the said James Kenna his heirs and assigns forever
 all the following particularly named described men-
 tioned and referred to lands parcels of land tracts parts
 of tracts and parcels of land tenements hereditaments
 rights and privileges lying and being in Frederick
 County and State aforesaid to wit all those tract-
 parts and portions of land tenements and hereditaments
