At the execution of the enclosed Commission issued out of the Circuit Court for Frederick County sitting as a Court of Equity and to me directed and empowering me to examine witnesses in a cause pending in said Court between the Central Bank of Frederick and others as Complainants and Sampson Kirma & others as Defendants & Mayson Eichelberger the Standing Commissioner duly qualified and proceed at my Law office in Frederick on Tuesday the 3<sup>rd</sup> day of November 1857 in the presence of the Solicitor for the Complainants and of some of the Defendants to take the following depositions: "Sampson Kirma a Witness of lawful age produced on the part of the Complainants being duly sworn & required to interrogatories filed with me by the Solicitor for the Complainants & hereunto returned answers and says. In the first Interrogatory I have known them all for a long time. In the second Interrogatory he is named as to this Witness. In the third Interrogatory James Kirma is dead he died the 3<sup>rd</sup> day of January 1857 leaving seven children viz Sampson Thomas David Mary Elizabeth Sarah Cassia Catharine Deborah William Cassa Amanda Kirma Mary is married to John Bizz Elygth to Martin Amy Amanda is married to John Clark they all reside in Frederick County except John Clark & Amanda his wife
