

falling due on the first days of October 1857 and 1858 and two
 sums of annuity interest on the whole of said unpaid purchase
 money have become due and payable on the two last men-
 tioned periods and still remain due and unpaid as in
 said bill stated and that four other instalments of said
 purchase money are yet to be come due and are owing
 and unpaid. And this respondent admits that the said
 Bernon & Lamar died intestate on the eleventh day of
 June in the year 1858, leaving a widow named Mary
 Lamar and six children his heirs at law to wit
 Anne Calum Marion Thomas George Albert Anne Mary
 William Bryant & John Clarence all of whom are
 infants under the age of twenty one year and all
 of whom reside in Frederick County and this respondent
 admits that administration was granted to the respondent
 by the Orphans Court of Frederick County upon the personal
 estate of said Bernon & Lamar and that he hath proce-
 ded to administer upon the same according to law
 This respondent further admits that the said Bernon
 & Lamar was largely indebted at the time of his death
 and that the personal estate of the said Bernon & Lamar
 is wholly insufficient to pay the other creditors of the
 said Bernon and the amount of the purchase money
 now due to the said complainant on the said land and
 the defendant admits that suits have been brought in the
 Circuit Court for Frederick County by sundry parties against
 this respondent, administrator of said Bernon prompts the
 February term last before it was ascertained by this respon-
 dent that the estate of the said Bernon would be unable
 to comply & fulfill the contract of the said Bernon
 & Lamar with the said Catharine Harper and this respon-
 dent admits and believes that the defendants in this
 case will be unable to comply with said contract
 and consents and agrees to the sale of the said land and
 submits to such decree in the premises as may be right and
 just admitting all and avers the other matters and things
 of any charge in said bill not herein specially admitted
 said bill assumed to be true, and the defendant as in duty
 bound will ever pray &c.
