In the names of God Amen I Hugh Eatheron of Kings  
County in the State of Pennsylvania being such in body  
but of sound and disposing mind knowing and being  
duly advised Considering the frailty of death and the  
uncertainty of the time thereof I being desirous to settle  
my worldly affairs and thereby to be better prepared  
to leave this world when it shall please God to call  
me hence do hereby make and publish this my  
last will and testament in writing and from  
following that is to say First and lastly I  
do give and bequeath unto the lands of Kings County  
and give I do to the earth to be decently buried  
at the discretion of my Executors hereafter named  
and after my death and funeral Charges are paid  
I devise and bequeath as follows 1<sup>st</sup> I give and  
devise unto Maynard Shields my half of the plantation  
whereof I now live being the plantation which was  
purchased by me and my brother John Eatheron by  
our father James Eatheron of Dec 9<sup>th</sup> 1791 and  
direct to said Maynard Shields for other tracts of  
land being and being in the State of Maryland  
under the name and adjoining the lands of  
Noah Mills Maryland and other Counties  
unto my said brother John Eatheron and the other tract join with the lands  
of Hugh Eatheron and other containing one hundred  
to three acres of land 3<sup>d</sup> I give and devise  
unto my said brother John Eatheron alias Peter Shields my  
undivided half of a tract of land which my brother  
John and myself purchased of James Cook being  
and being in Adams County State of Pennsylvania
