To the Hon Mr Wilson Judge of the Circuit Court for Frederick
County as a Court of Equity The Bill of Complaint of
Jacob Mc Wachter of Frederick County who says as well
for himself as all other Creditors of Henry Haugh late
of said County deceased who will come in & contribute
to the expenses of this suit humbly shews that said
deceased was in his life time indebted unto your orator
in the sum of twenty seven dollars and forty three Cent
current money for sundry matters and things properly
chargeable in account as by your orators Exhibit A -
filed as a part of this bill will more fully and at
large appear and your orator further shews that the
said Henry Haugh departed this life intestate in the
month of June or July in the year 1858 leaving Catharine
Haugh his widow Mary A & Haugh John H Haugh Joseph
L Haugh Eliza A the wife of John Blackstone Isaac H -
Haugh Benjamin J Haugh Almira Haugh Ann R Haugh
& Louisa L Haugh his children & heirs at law that
said widow and heirs at law all reside in Frederick
County except the said John Blackstone & Eliza A his
wife who reside in Anne County that said named
heirs at law are all adults except Benjamin J Haugh
Almira Haugh Ann R Haugh and Louisa L Haugh
who are infants under twenty one year of age
Your orator further charges that said intestate at the
time of his death was seized and possessed in fee of a
lot of ground in Frederick County described in a deed
from John L Haugh to said intestate a Certified
Copy of which is herewith filed as a part of this
Bill & marked Exhibit B and was also seized and
possessed in fee of another piece of ground containing
about two acres more or less adjoining the lot described
in said Exhibit B which said last piece of ground
