And your orator further charges that shortly after the death of the said Henry Haugh letters of Administration on his personal estate were in due form issued by the Orphans Court of Frederick County unto his widow the said Catharine Haugh & in fulfillment of which letters are herewith filed as a part of this bill & marked by exhibit to that said administration has in virtue of said letters of administration possessed herself of all the personal estate left by the said intestate at the time of his death - And your orator is informed that the said personal estate is insufficient to pay the just debts of said deceased and your orator is advised that as the personal estate of the said Henry Haugh deceased in the hands of his administration is insufficient for the payment of all his just debts your orator and his other creditors yet unsatisfied are entitled to have their claims paid out of the real estate of the said deceased in the hands of his widow of her aforesaid. To the end therefore that the defendants hereinafter named may answer the several matters and things hereinafter charged as fully and particularly as if they were thereto interrogated and that the real estate of the said deceased or so much thereof as may be necessary for the purpose aforesaid may be sold for the payment of the claims of your orator and of the other unsatisfied claims of the other creditors of said deceased and that your orator may have such other and further relief in the premises as Equity and good Conscience may require may it please your Honor to grant unto your orator the writ of Subpoena against the said John Blackstone and Eliza A Blackstone his wife to be directed to the Sheriff of Carroll County commanding them to appear in the Court at a certain day to be therein named to answer the premises and affidavits by & perform such decree as may be passed thereon and also the writ of Subpoena against the said Catharine Haugh widow & administratrix aforesaid and against the said Mary A Haugh John H Haugh and Sarah A Haugh his wife Joseph L Haugh Isaac W Haugh Benjamin F Haugh - George Haugh Ann B Haugh & Sophia Haugh of Frederick County commanding them to appear
