

Be it remembered and it is hereby certified that on the 15th day of January one thousand eight hundred and forty one before the subscribers two Justices of the peace of the State of Maryland in and for Frederick County personally appeared Daniel & Goole and Amy Goole his wife they being known to us to be the persons named and described as and professing to be parties to the foregoing indenture and do severally acknowledge the said Indenture to be their respective act and deed the said Amy Goole having signed and sealed said Indenture before us out of the presence and hearing of her said husband and being examined by us out of the presence and hearing of her said husband whether she doth recite and acknowledge the same freely and voluntarily and without being induced to do so by fear or threats of ill usage by her said husband or by fear of his displeasure do declare and saith that she doth.
