 always that until default is made in the payment of the said  
 sum of five hundred dollars current and the interest as  
 herein before provided that it shall and may be lawful to  
 and the said Jacob Appelman his heirs executors and administrators  
 to hold the said parts and parcels of land and premises as  
 hereby granted and released or intended and meant to be so  
 with their and every of their appurtenances and the rents issues  
 profits and produce thereof to take and receive to their own use  
 without any lawful let suit interruption disturbance claim or  
 demand whatsoever of from or by the said Henry Corne and
