This Cause standing ready
for hearing and being submitted without argument the
proceedings were read and considered it is therefore
this 7th day of February in the year of our Lord one thousand
eight hundred and fifty nine by Madison Wilson Judge
of the third Judicial Circuit of the State of Maryland -
and by the authority of the Circuit Court for Frederick
County as a Court of Equity adjudged ordered & decreed
that the real estate in the proceedings mentioned be sold
for the payment of the debts of George Blum deceased that
George H. Blum of Frederick County be and he is hereby
appointed trustee to make such sale and that the
course and manner of his proceedings shall be as follows
He shall first file in the Clerk's office a bond to the State of
Maryland executed by himself with a surety or sureties to be
approved by the Court or Clerk thereof in the penalty of six
thousand dollar conditioned for the faithful performance
of the trust imposed in him by this decree or which may be
imposed on him by any future order or decree in the premises
He shall then proceed to make sale of the said real estate
having first given at least three weeks previous notice men-
ted for some newspaper printed in Frederick and such other
notice as he may think proper of the time place manner and
terms of sale which terms shall be as follows one third cash to
