In the Hon. Mr. Nelson Judge of the Circuit Court for Gardner County sitting as a Court of Equity The Petitioner of Peter & Schlofer respectfully shows that after giving bond with approved security as required by the decree he advertised the property specified in the proceedings in the above case for three weeks in the Gardner Examiner & by paid bills extensively circulated thereby giving notice of the time, place, manner & terms of sale & attended at Lewis town on Thursday the first day of March 1880 pursuant to said notice & then and there offered at public sale a certain lot containing 34 acres of land being part of the lot known as the Dietrich Lot heretofore conveyed to George Schlofer by Henry Lorentz & wife by deed dated the 9th day of March 1857 & described as Lots Nos 1 & 2 on the plat herewith filed marked Exhibit No 1 to trustees report of sales & sold the same to William B. Todd & Edward J. Getzenman at & for the price of five dollars per acre, they being then and there the highest bidders for the same the purchase money for the same amounting to one hundred & twenty dollars. Your trustee then offered the tract of land lying on the North side of Lewistown adjoining the Gardner & Emmettsburg Turnpike Road, containing 35 acres one Rod & twenty five perches of land specified in a deed from John Walker to George Schlofer dated the first day of April 1817 & being Lot No C D on the aforesaid plat & sold the same to Ephraim Devils at & for the sum of forty dollars & fifty cents per acre the whole purchase money for the same amounting to fourteen hundred and thirty three dollars & ninety four cents. Your trustee then offered a lot on the East side of Lewistown adjoining the said turnpike road containing seven acres one Rod & twenty eight perches it being the same specified on the said plat as Lot No 1 by Square & sold the same to Jacob Bishop at & for the price of thirty eight dollars & fifty cents per acre the whole purchase money for the same amounting to two hundred
